Thorpe Park: Saturday 18th October

Dear Scouts,

On Saturday 18th October we'll be heading to Thorpe Park. Whether you're looking for a heart stopping thrills, mind-bending chills and intense forces or you're into the more relaxed Logger's Leap and Rumba Rapids then Thorpe Park has something to offer.

We'll leave Basingstoke around 9am and travel to Thorpe Park by train, returning in the evening. Exact times will be confirmed closer to the date. During the day you'll get to explore the park and experience the rides you want to enjoy.

The cost for this full day of activity is just £33.



Booking a Place

To book a place you must return the attached form and the full cost no later than Tuesday 7th October. As we need to buy tickets in advance it will not be possible to book a place after this date.

What will I need to bring?

You'll need to bring a packed lunch, plenty to drink and a waterproof coat in case it rains (we can provide bin liners for anyone who forgets...). You'll need to wear your Scout shirt and scarf but you can wear any trousers and shoes. You might also want to bring some spending money. You'll need to be able to carry anything you bring so a bag may be helpful!

If you have a mobile phone it might be useful to bring it along to help communicate if you get lost in the park - however if you do this is at your own risk as we cannot accept responsibility for any damage that might occur.

Note: The medical profession takes the view that the parent's consent to medical treatment cannot be delegated. This view is explicit in the Children Act 1989. Thus medical consent forms have no legal status and a doctor/nurse insisting on the consent of a parent to a particular treatment has the right to do so. For this reason, we do not recommend that Leaders insist on parents signing the statement above. However, it can be a comfort to medical staff to have general consent in advance from parents or to have a Leader on hand able to sign forms required by medical authorities.
